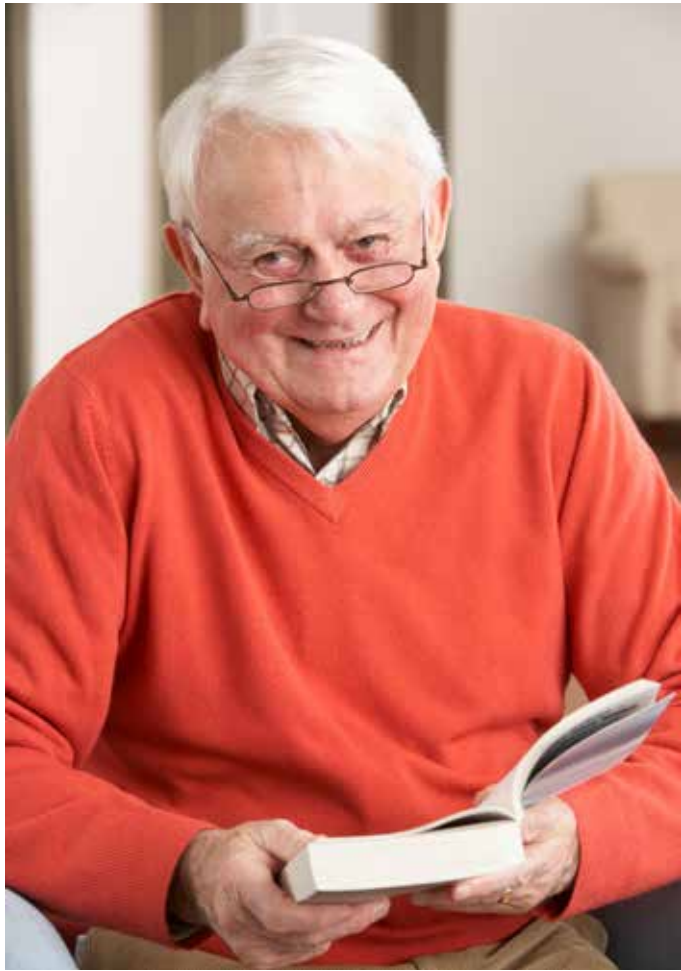

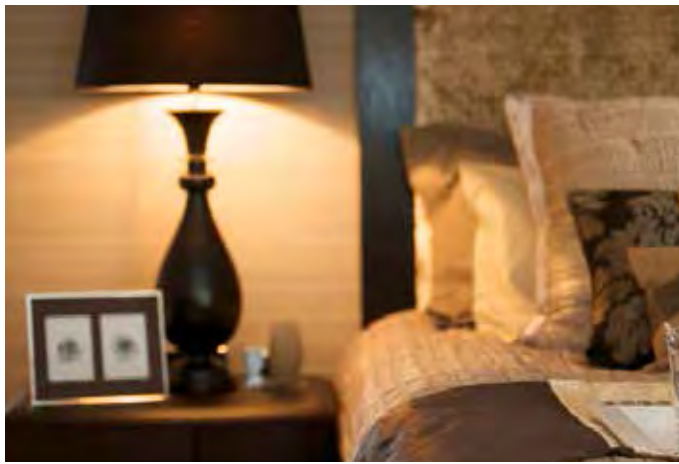

Decor and design second to none

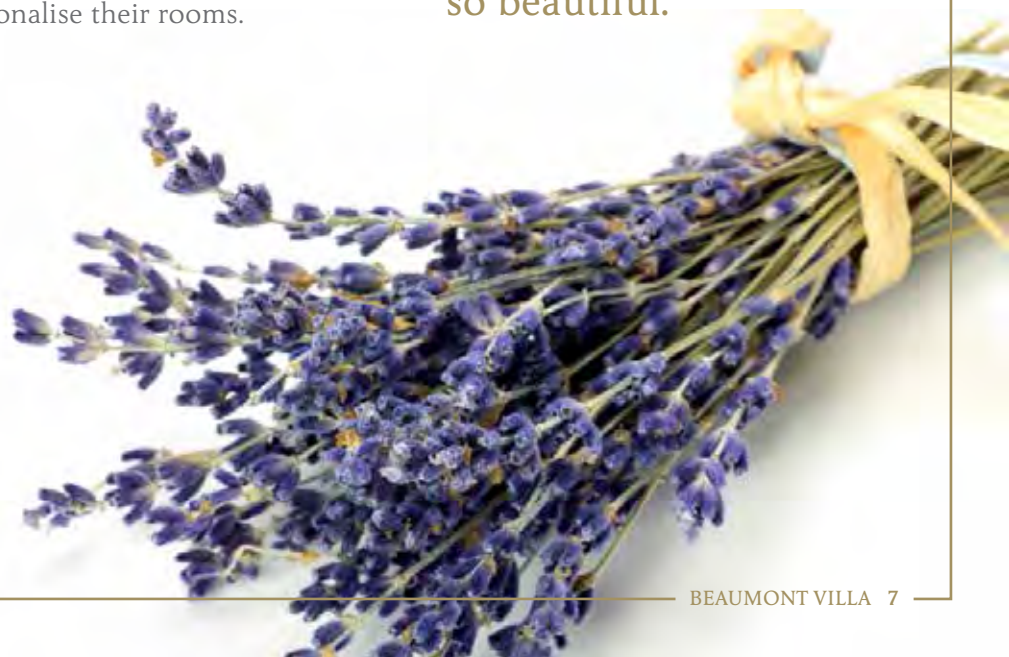

Island charm with a wealth of activities



Lying on the edge of the tranquil village of St Peter, near Jersey’s breathtakingly beautiful west coast, Beaumont Villa enjoys all the benefits of this most loved Channel Island. Jersey’s temperate climate ensures a wide range of outdoor activities are available year round for residents and family members alike.

A popular destination is Les Mielles Nature Reserve, little more than a mile to the west on the coast. The Reserve offers an

abundance of walks and quiet scenic spots for a picnic. An absolute highlight is Le Noir Pré (the Orchid Field), comprising two adjoining wet meadows and one of the last remaining strongholds of the Jersey or Loose-flowered Orchid (*Orchis laxiflora*).

Beaumont lies within easy reach of St Helier, which offers regular ferry services to Portsmouth, St Peter’s Port Guernsey and St Malo, and is only a short distance from the island’s main airport.
